

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALL MEETING OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HELD ON JUNE 13, 2017 AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE COMMISSIONERS CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COURTHOUSE.

Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Huck Greene gave the invocation.

The first item on the agenda was the 2018 LMIG projects. Road Superintendent Adam Dowdy presented three roads that he felt was at the top of the list. They were Cannonville Road to Highway 233 for 2.7 miles, Cardinal Road from Highway 159 to Pleasantview Road for 1.1 miles and Copeland Road from Christian Home Road to Branch Road for 1.8 miles. Commissioner Jowan Johnson made a motion to apply for these three roads. Commissioner Alfonza Hall seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

The closure of Pintail Lane was the next item of business. Commissioner Alfonza Hall stated he felt we should leave the road open since it is a connector road between Cannonville Road and Highway 129 which reduces emergency response time. Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion to leave the road open. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

The next item of business was the closure of Doster Road. Commissioner Clay Reid stated he felt the road should remain open. The bridge on the road is rated 92.1 by DOT which means it is in good condition. We have no other problems with the road other than what we talked about at the regular monthly meeting. The Emergency agencies suggest that it be left open also. Commissioner Clay Reid then put this in a motion. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Chairman Lanier Keene addressed the request that had been received from Jerry Sercer. He stated the landfill is monitored monthly. Freddie Hattaway has informed us the best he can tell the old fence line is the property line. He added the County has no cows so he recommended the county not put up the fence. Chairman Lanier Keene then put this in the form of a motion. Commissioner Huck Greene seconded the motion that carried unanimously. Commissioner Clay Reid added the County is going to replace the pipe at the sediment pond and the erosion problem.

There being no further business, Commissioner Huck Greene made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Clay Reid seconded the motion that carried unanimously.
